

CASUAL MINISTERIAL DRIVERS RATES OF PAY AND CONDITIONS
NSW DEPARTMENT OF PREMIER AND CABINET

Section 52(1) Supplementary Determination No 3 of 2016

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1. The Industrial Relations Secretary has determined, pursuant to section 52 of the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013* (NSW) the conditions of employment for Ministerial Drivers employed on a casual basis in the NSW Department of Premier and Cabinet.

2. RATES OF PAY AND CONDITIONS

2.1. The hourly rate of pay for a casual Ministerial Driver shall be calculated by reference to the annual salary for a Ministerial Driver provided for in clause 4 of the *Ministerial Drivers' Salaries and Conditions – New South Wales Department of Premier and Cabinet Section 130(1) Determination No. 953 of 2007* (2007 Determination), as varied from time to time by the *Crown Employees (Public Sector - Salaries 2016) Award* or any variation or replacement Award.

2.2. Casual drivers shall be provided with the conditions of employment as set out in clause 12 of the *Crown Employees (Public Service Conditions of Employment) Reviewed Award 2009*. The casual rate of pay for Ministerial Drivers is calculated on the basis of ordinary working hours being 38 hours per week.

2.3. The Out of Hours Work Allowance provided at clause 4 of the 2007 Determination does not apply to casual Ministerial Drivers.

3. AREA, INCIDENCE AND DURATION

3.1. This Determination is supplementary to and to be read in conjunction with the *Ministerial Drivers' Salaries and Conditions – New South Wales Department of Premier and Cabinet Section 130(1) Determination No. 953 of 2007*.

3.2. This Determination applies to those persons employed by the Department of Premier and Cabinet under the classification of Ministerial Driver on a casual basis and shall take effect on and from the date of signing, and shall remain in force until varied or rescinded.
