

**SESSIONAL MUSICIANS, CORRECTIVE SERVICES NSW
SECTION 52 (1) DETERMINATION NO. 2/2019**

1. INTRODUCTION

This Determination is made pursuant to section 52(1) of the *Government Sector Employment Act 2013*, to formalise the payment of wages and conditions of employment for Corrective Services NSW (CSNSW) casual Sessional Musicians.

2. CLASSIFICATION

CSNSW Sessional Musician employees are engaged in the following classifications:

Sessional Musician
Drum Major
Principal Sessional Musician

3. SALARIES

Sessional Musician, Drum Major and Principal Sessional Musician classifications are paid an hourly rate of pay in accordance with the *Crown Employees (Public Sector – Salaries 2018) Award* as set out below:

Classification	Common Salary Point	Annual salary	Current Casual Hourly Rate (from FFPP 1 July 2018)
Sessional Musician	32	\$55,747.00	\$30.63
Drum Major	39	\$59,411.00	\$32.64
Principal Sessional Musician	39	\$59,411.00	\$32.64

The hourly rate is calculated based on 35 hours per week.

The above salaries shall be varied to reflect any variations in *Crown Employees (Public Sector – Salaries 2018) Award* or to any award replacing it by way of general salary increase.

4. HOURS OF WORK


Sessional Musicians are employed on a casual as needs basis including evenings and weekends.

5. EMPLOYMENT CONDITIONS

Except where specifically varied by this Determination, the *Crown Employees (Public Service Conditions of Employment) Reviewed Award 2009* and the *Crown Employees (Public Sector – Salaries 2018) Award* or any award replacing those awards shall apply.
